Beginning March 25: Student guidelines for learning time and activities

Please note that these guidelines are suggestions, not mandatory activities. They are intended to provide students an opportunity to engage in learning activities from home.

| Pre-K | Typical school schedule: 3 hours of instruction • Modified schedule: 20-25 minutes of daily activity • 5 minutes of being read to & engaging in texts • 5 minutes of counting/math literacy • 5 minutes of letter identification • 5-10 minutes of creativeness (building, drawing, etc.) • Additional time as desired for play/PE |

| K-2 | Typical school schedule: 6.5 hours of instruction/lunch/recess • Modified schedule: 40 total daily minutes • 25 minutes of literacy - this could include independent reading, being read to, writing, or reading using reading platforms • 15 minutes of math using iReady platform or print out activities • Additional time as desired for play/PE |
| 3-5 | Typical school schedule: 6.5 hours of instruction/lunch/recess • Modified schedule: 50 total daily minutes • 30 minutes of literacy - this could include independent reading, being read to, writing, or reading using reading platforms • 20 minutes of math using iReady platform or print out activities • Additional time as desired for play/PE |
| 6-8 | Typical school schedule: 6.5 hours of instruction/lunch • Modified schedule: 60-75 total daily minutes ○ 20 minutes of independent reading daily ○ 10-15 minutes each of review/enrichment for ELA, math, science and social studies on Mondays and Wednesdays, distributed via Google Classroom. ○ 10-15 minutes each of review/enrichment for Encore courses on Tuesdays and Thursdays, distributed via Google Classroom ○ Additional time as desired for play/PE |

| 9-12 | Typical school schedule: 6.5 hours of instruction/lunch • Modified schedule: 60-120 total daily minutes |
